Методические рекомендации по выполнению контрольных заданий и оформлению контрольных работ:

- 1. Все задания контрольной работы выполняются поочередно, в той последовательности, в которой они представлены в работе.
- 2. Письменные контрольные задания оформляются в отдельной тетради. На обложке тетради проставляется фамилия студента, номер контрольной работы.
- 3. Контрольная работа должна быть выполнена чернилами, аккуратно, четким почерком. В тетради для замечаний, объяснений и методических указаний преподавателя необходимо оставить широкие поля.
- 4. В конце работы должна быть поставлена подпись студента и дата выполнения задания.
- 5. Материал контрольных заданий следует располагать по следующему образцу:

левая страница	правая страница

- 6. Для проверки и рецензирования выполненную контрольную работу необходимо направить в университет в установленные сроки.
- 7. Если контрольная работа выполнена без соблюдения указаний и не полностью, она возвращается студенту без проверки.

HOW TO GET PUBLISHED IN MAGAZINES

Whether you're a full-time freelance writer or an aspiring essayist hoping to get published for the first time, the process of <u>publishing</u> articles can be arduous and labor-intensive. It takes more than a great story and distinct writing style to get your article published. Once you finish writing, the work has only just begun. So you wrote a great magazine article. Now what? For many freelancers, the publication process can seem confusing and complex.

Choose a topic you're passionate about. Before you can <u>see</u> your byline in a magazine publication or website, you'll need <u>to come up</u> with a great article idea. Don't be afraid to write a personal story. Oftentimes, personal stories offer the best opportunity for new writers to showcase their unique perspective, writing skills, and writing style. On the other hand, if you're passionate about <u>writing</u> articles that require research and in-depth analysis, you should <u>consider</u> story ideas that allow you to do that. What's important is that you're enthusiastic about your idea. That will make the creative work that much easier.

You should set aside a fair amount of time for research before you start <u>writing</u>. Even if your subject area doesn't require extensive investigation or outside source material for the writing portion, you should familiarize yourself with the type of work generally <u>accepted</u> by the publications to which you intend to submit. If you're <u>planning</u> on submitting to online publications, go to the outlet's homepage and look through their <u>published</u> articles. If they have already published work or journal articles that are similar to yours, you may need to figure out a new angle. Then, you can start writing your article.

Selectively <u>choosing</u> the right journals, magazines, or online publications to submit to can save you a lot of time and effort. Determine the best type of magazine for your work. Your niche might be a literary magazine or a consumer magazine. Perhaps your work is appropriate for a trade publication or academic journal. <u>Submitting</u> a hard news article to a journal that mostly publishes short stories and personal essays, for instance, will likely not be worth your time. If you're <u>trying</u> to get published online, go to the publication's website and look at their editorial policy, as well as stories that they've published in the last year.

Submit your article. Each one has its own submission guidelines, so be sure to carefully read the instructions before submitting. If you're submitting by email, the journal might have specific requirements about what to put in the subject line and which editor or associate editor to submit to.

After you submit, don't be afraid to follow up if you haven't <u>heard</u> back in a week or two. These publications likely receive a lot of submissions, and it's easy for an email to get buried - especially if this is the first article you've submitted to them.
